42.5	Grid	Deer fencing begins on right near the dam.
43.3	Steep incline.	
44.0	Basalt quarry on lower left.	At the top of the hill are sweeping views south and over the Anduramba Range.
44.3	Take left at Y junction. This is Waterhole Gully Rd.	Homestead with 316 number.
45.1	On left, waterhole with lillies.	Bird life.
45.3	Take left fork.	Right fork is a private road.
46.3	Grid.	Sign on tyre "Caution Cattle". Massive ironbarks. Road follows creek.
46.9	Grid.	
47.5	Beautiful waterhole.	Look out for small red/yellow triangles on trees marking the Bicentennial National Trail.
47.8	Grid.	Excellent birding site.
47.9	Waterhole with bullrushes and nearby trees.	Views to the Jimna and northern ranges.
48.8	Top of the hill.	Creek to the right, old windmill and tank to the left.
49.4	Grid.	
49.9	Large waterhole on right.	
51.2	Grid at top of hill.	Shed down to right.
51.5	Deer fencing on right.	
52.3	Extensive views south.	Grass trees are plentiful around here.
52.6	Property on right, "Wayta Buggary."	
53.6	Steep rocky pinch.	
53.9	Begin steep descent.	Engage 4WD and lowest gear. Extensive views of hoop pine state forests to north (Benarkin State Forest.)
55.2		Impressive roadside granite tors.
55.6	End steep grade down. Emu Creek crossing.	Concrete spillway, but check depth and speed of water if relevant.
55.8	Take wheel tracks on left for 50 m to beautiful picnic spot.	Very picturesque, smooth rocks for kids, small fish. Return to road.
56.1	Start rough, steep climb.	Engage 4WD and lowest gear.
57.1	Do not take Spelling Gully Rd to left.	This becomes private property at 1.9 km up the hill!
57.2	Googa Googa Creek crossing.	Granite rock base.
57.3	Gate.	
58.1	Gate.	Leave them as you find them.
58.2	Creek crossing. Waterhole Gully Rd ends. Turn left at T junction.	
58.6	Grid.	
59.4	Fauna reserve surrounds property on left.	You are now travelling through a fauna sanctuary and a Droughtmaster cattle stud.
61.9	Do not take Cherry Creek Rd to right.	Cherry Creek B&B down this road. Red volcanic soils. Avocados on both sides, harvested in spring.
63.0	Do not take Back Valley Rd.	
63.3	Turn right to Blackbutt at T junction	Alternative: Turn left to return to Crows Nest via Pierces Creek Rd.
63.8		Hydroponic farm. Macadamia nut plantation.
